





Academic Requirements

Rules Regarding School discipline

- English medium school, therefore students alongwith staff should speak English only, so as to enhance their spoken English skills.
- The students are expected to keep the classroom neat and tidy. Writing on the walls or spitting is prohibited.
- All students are required set in their respective classrooms 5 minutes before the commencement of the class. The students are expected to sit quietly before the teacher arrives.
- Every absence or leave must to entered in the leave record, pages of the school diary and duly signed by the parents or guardian.
- Repeated absence without information for more than 10 days shall render the students liable to have his name struck-off the roll.
- Mobile phones are not allowed in the school campus.
- Friends and relatives are not allowed in the campus without prior permission.
- Computer and other similar technological instruments will be used only for academic needs.
- Any damage to the property of the institution by the students will be treated seriously.
- Exchange of articles or money transactions between the students is not allowed.
- Use of abusive language is restricted.

Identity Card

Every student is issued an identity card by the School which is renewed every year. It is mandatory for the students to carry identity card with them every day. In case of any kind of default the identity-card will be confiscated as a disciplinary action. In case of loss of identity card the students are advised to intimate the school office immediately. Duplicate identity card will be issued on payment of Rs. 50/-. Any change of address should be notified by the students. Violation of any rules and regulation will be strictly treated and can lead to suspension / removal from school

The Hostel

The Hostel is exclusively meant for boys. Each Room is made for accommodation of two students. TV room, Dinning Hall, Mess, Canteen, Co-operative Store and washing facility is available to students. The Hostel is directly under the control of the Principal whose authority is final in all matters. He is assisted by a teacherwarden, warden and the Hostel Admission Committee which is responsible for all admissions in the Hostel. The management reserves the right to give or not to give hostel to the student who applies for it.

Procedure for Admission

The Hostel Application form is available with school prospectus.

- All the students desiring Hostel accommodation should submit the application form attached to the school prospectus duly filled by the last date prescribed for submission of school Admission forms. This application should be submitted to the Hostel Incharge.
- Students seeking admission to the Hostel should register themselves in the Hostel Office.
- Admission to the hostel will be considerd only on the basis of registration after admission to the school. At the time of the registration students should submit the counterfoil of their hostel application form and photocopy of receipt of the fees deposited in the school.
- Late submission of admission

not be considered.

- The student is to be accompanied by his parents and local guardian; both at the time of admission and readmission.
- Parents/Guardians are advised to see physically, the facilities available in hostel before getting admission of their ward.
 School will not be responsible for any complaint made there after.

Criteria for Admission/Readmission

Admission

- A student who has secured admission in the school can apply for Hostel accommodation only he has a good academic record.
- He is not residing in 10 k.m. area in or around the school (consider, school campus as center)
- Medical Certificate of fitness should be submitted.
- Affidavit for following rules of Hostel and School.

Readmission

Readmission is made afresh every year with all the formalities applicable to a new admission. Admission will not be granted:-

- If he /she has failed in the previous class.
- If he/she has failed to secured 75% attendance in the class.
- If he/she violated the hostel rules or has been guilty of breach of discipline or has committed acts of misconduct.

Date of Joining and Leaving the Hostel

- The hostel starts functioning one day before the school starts.
- All students are required to attend the orientation programme held in the school on the Ist day of the academic year. Those admitted to the hostel are therefore required to report one day prior to the opening of the school. If they fail to do so they will be disallowed.
- During Summer, Diwali, winter vacation and or any holiday the hostel will remain closed and residents are expected to go home.
- The students must vacate the hostel within two days after the end of Annual Examinations for the year in which admission is sought. In case of overstay a fine of Rs. 100/- per day will be charged.
- Any student failing to return to the Hostel after expiry of his vacation, without prior intimation, will be liable to disciplinary action which could be expulsion from the Hostel, or heavy fine for the period overstayed

Accommodation and Facilities

- Types of accommodation available Shared rooms (two students).
- The Hostel Incharge in consultation with Principal allocates the rooms.
- All rooms are fitted with ceiling fans.
- Each room is provided with one Almirah, one bed, one gadra, one pillow, one desk and a chair for each student.
- Resident students are required to bring their own blankets, towels, curtains.

- table lamp, two CFL of 16 or 22 watts(energy saving), bucket, mug, water bottle, glass, thermos flask, torch, thermometer, lock, key and dusters etc.
- Facilities for washing and ironing is available three days in a week as per schedule.
- Indoor and outdoor games are provided during the sports hour daily.
- Students are not allowed to go outside the campus for telephone. Calls can be done or received from hostel/canteen telephone booth as per time schedule 1.00 pm to 6.00 pm (Sunday)
- Medical Aid facility is available through the Trust Hospital with common medicines available.The students can avail the facility at the nominal fee of Rs.5/- per slip. In case of emergency a student is taken to the Trust hospital and on its recommendation to nearby Hospital and the local guardian duly informed. The local guardian will take charge of the ward thereafter and the medical expenses etc. will have to be borne by him\her in this connection. The entire responsibility for treatment will rest with the parents/local guardians. The facilities mentioned any where in prospectus, will be provided by us at our best, but cannot be claimed as a right by student.

Visitors

 Allowed Visitors can meet their Ward/son on any Sunday during 10a.m – 4p.m at the

- allocated place other than hostel.
- Visitors/Parents must sign the Visitors
 Book on their arrival and fill up the
 necessary details. They are not allowed to
 go in Hostel.
- Visitors must leave their vehicles at the parking place near the school gate.

Rules and Regulations

- No leave will be given in mid of session. In case of emergency for leave in Midsession, the parents/local guardians will write well in advance to the Principal/warden about the time and place their son/ward is to go. The Principal reserves the right of not giving the leave to the student. Leave will be given as per calendar only.
- Students are required to follow the Time Table of Hostel strictly as per schedule.
 Severe action will be taken against students, who abet other students, whether in breaking the rules or in undermining the discipline of the hostel.
- Silence bell rings after dinner/milk on which all resident students are expected to be in their respective rooms and maintain silence. Immediately after it the gate of Hostel will be locked. Defaulters will be fined and may be expelled from hostel too.
- All resident students must abide by any new rule/rules that may be introduced during any part of the year.
- Maintenance of Room
 - a) The resident is responsible for the

- care and maintenance of the room and furniture provided to him. Any damage done will be recovered from residents.
- b) No additional furniture will be allowed in the room.
- their rooms tidy. Rooms are subjected to check by the hostel Incharge/Warden at any time. Any damage or disfiguring of wall, cupboard, etc. is subject to fine of Rs.200/-. Defaulters will be fined for each default found during regular checking of the rooms. Sticking posters on the walls, cupboards are strictly prohibited.
- d) Residents are required to maintain cleanliness of their rooms, bathrooms and corridors. Bins are provided for the collection of litter, fruit peels etc.
- e) Cooking is not permitted in the rooms.
- f) The use of any electrical appliances like heater, immersion rod, iron, stove, etc. inside the rooms is strictly prohibited. The appliance will be confiscated and a fine of Rs.200/- will be imposed on offenders.
- g) Transistors/ tape recorders/two-inone/any musical instrument/mobile phone etc. will not be allowed.
- h) Every student on leaving his room shall switch off the light and fan. Defaulters will be fined Rs.100/- in

- case a fan or light is not switched off before proceeding for vacation.
- The electricity bill if found more than the regular amount collected, shall be borne equally by all the residents.
- j) No student shall carry on activities in his room, which cause disturbance or annoyance to his neighbors in the hostel or school authorities. Disciplinary action will be taken against such students by the Hostel authorities.

General Rule of conduct

- a) Smoking, consuming liquor and drugs are strictly prohibited. Strong disciplinary action would be taken if this rule is violated.
- Students are required to maintain silence in the corridors and the room.
 They are not allowed in School building after School hours.
- c) Night apparel is not permitted in the dining hall or in the visitor's room.
- d) No crockery or food is to be taken out of the dining hall. Food is not to be wasted.

- e). Students are expected to keep their rooms, bathrooms and their surrounding tidy.
- f) Residents are not to disfigure the walls, cupboards alloted to them. They are also not to disfigure the walls of the corridors and of the common area. Fine is liable to be charged for every default.
- g) They are accountable for any misuse or loss of school property allotted to them.
- h) For any requirement, repair or complaint, a resident student must give in writing to the warden. The compliant register will be available with warden.
- i) It is compulsory to attend spiritual class daily by residents in prescribed uniform. Otherwise student will not be allowed to stay in hostel.
- j) Students in the hostel must wear the prescribed uniform of hostel.

Note: Any Violation of the Hostel rules would lead to Fine /Suspension/Vacating the Hostel and School seat or all three.






